## Transfer Core Curriculum Los Rios Community College District Folsom Lake College 2007-08

ALL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE CORE CURRICULUM TO GRADUATE FROM THE UNIVERSITY. IT IS **NOT** NECESSARY TO MEET ALL OF THE LOWER DIVISION CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE BEFORE TRANSFERRING TO UNR.
