## Transfer Core Curriculum Sierra College 2009-10

ALL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE CORE CURRICULUM TO GRADUATE FROM THE UNIVERSITY. IT IS **NOT** NECESSARY TO MEET ALL OF THE LOWER DIVISION CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE BEFORE TRANSFERRING TO UNR.

CH 203 SUBSTITUTION = HISTORY 17A\* OR POL.SCI. 1\* (MUST ALSO COMPLETE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING COURSES AT UNR FOR FULL CH 203 CREDIT: HIST 217; PSC 100, 208)
