Admission Requirements

High School Students:

- Graduation from an accredited or approved high school.
- Students must have at least a 2.75 (weighted) grade point average (GPA) in the required high school courses listed below in order to be admitted to the University of Nevada, Reno. A weighted GPA takes into account the extra difficulty of honors, advanced placement or international baccalaureate classes.
- Completion of the following high school courses:

ENGLISH: Emphasis on composition; rhetoric; American, British and World Literature.	4 years
MATHEMATICS: Algebra or higher level mathematics, including first and second year algebra, geometry, trigonometry or other advanced mathematics	3 years
NATURAL SCIENCE: Such as biology, chemistry and physics. Two years in a laboratory science required.	3 years
SOCIAL SCIENCE/STUDIES: Includes world history and geography, U.S. history, economics, government and law.	3 years
TOTAL	13 units

Transfer Students:

Admission as a transfer student requires the successful completion of a minimum of 24 transferable semester college credits with at least a 2.3 cumulative grade point average. Transfer students are not required to submit ACT/SAT scores.

**Applying for Admission
Procedure and Checklist**

- 1. Complete and submit the admission application online at www.unr.edu. A non-refundable \$60 application fee, payable by credit card or check, must accompany your application. Application fee applies only to the semester in which you apply.
- 2. Official transcripts containing a proper signature, date and institution seal must be sent directly from the school or college issuing the transcript to:

Transcripts submitted for admission will not be returned to the applicant. Current high school students and high school graduates must provide an official high school transcript. High school students who have taken college courses must submit official transcripts from the high school and the college.

Transfer students who have completed 24 or more transferable college semester credits must supply an official college transcript only.

- 3. Submit ACT and/or SAT test scores to the Office of Admissions and Records. Scores are used for placement in math and English courses and for scholarship consideration if received by February 1. Transfer students are not required to submit ACT/SAT scores.
- 4. Send a copy of your immunization records to the Office of Admissions and Records. Your immunizations must include:
 - Two doses of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR)
 - One diphtheria/tetanus (DT) within last ten years
 - Students born prior to 1957 are exempt from the MMR requirements.
 - Immunizations are available at your local county health department or at the Student Health Center.
- 5. University of Nevada, Reno scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit. For priority consideration for scholarships, you must be admitted and have submitted ACT/SAT scores by February 1. After that date, awards are made based upon available funds.

University of Nevada, Reno Scholarship Awards

February 1 *Priority Scholarship Consideration*
After February 1 *Awards Based on Available Funds*

Apply for admission early in the fall to maximize your opportunity for university scholarships. The University of Nevada awards merit scholarships to incoming freshmen based upon grade point average (GPA) and ACT or SAT test scores. New transfer students are evaluated by college GPA.

For priority consideration for scholarships, students must be admitted to the university by February 1. After February 1, awards are made based upon available funds.

Good Neighbor **\$225 per credit**
Good Neighbor policy applies to eligible residents of: Alpine, El Dorado, Inyo, Lassen, Modoc, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, San Bernardino and Sierra counties in California. Students must prove eligibility for this program. Good Neighbor participants are ineligible to change residency status for tuition purposes.

Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE) **\$163.88 per credit**
States participating in the WUE program are: Arizona, Alaska, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington and Wyoming. WUE participants are ineligible to change residency status for tuition purposes and all programs of study are open to WUE students on a space-available basis.

New Student Orientation Fee **\$95 one time fee**
Due the first semester of full time enrollment.

Health and Counseling Fees **\$105 per semester**
All students enrolled in 6 or more credits.

Nevada Residency & Tuition Instructions

Independent students must prove residency in Nevada for at least 6 months prior to the date of matriculation. ***Students will not be classified as Nevada residents until proper documentation is received.**

Documentation Needed for Nevada Residency (as applicable)

- Graduate of a Nevada high school or Good Neighbor high school or community college, or Millennium Scholar: *Send official transcript.*
- Full-time employee of a public school in the state of Nevada or a professional or classified employee of NSHE or the spouse or dependent child of such an employee: *Send a copy of current employee contract. Include marriage certificate or copy of federal income tax return if spouse or dependent.*
- Member of the Armed Forces of the United States stationed in Nevada or dependent: *Send a copy of military orders that indicate Nevada as a permanent duty station. Include marriage certificate or tax return if spouse or dependent. Members of the National Guard and other reserve forces are not eligible.*
- Financially independent person who has relocated to Nevada for the primary purpose of permanent full-time employment or a financially dependent person whose family or legal guardian has relocated to Nevada for the primary purpose of permanent full-time employment: *Send a copy of employer documentation of full-time employment. Dependent students include a copy of parent or legal guardian's income tax return that claims you as a dependent.*
- Person who is financially dependent upon a parent or legal guardian who is a resident of Nevada: *Send a copy of parent or legal guardian's income tax return that claims you as a dependent.*
