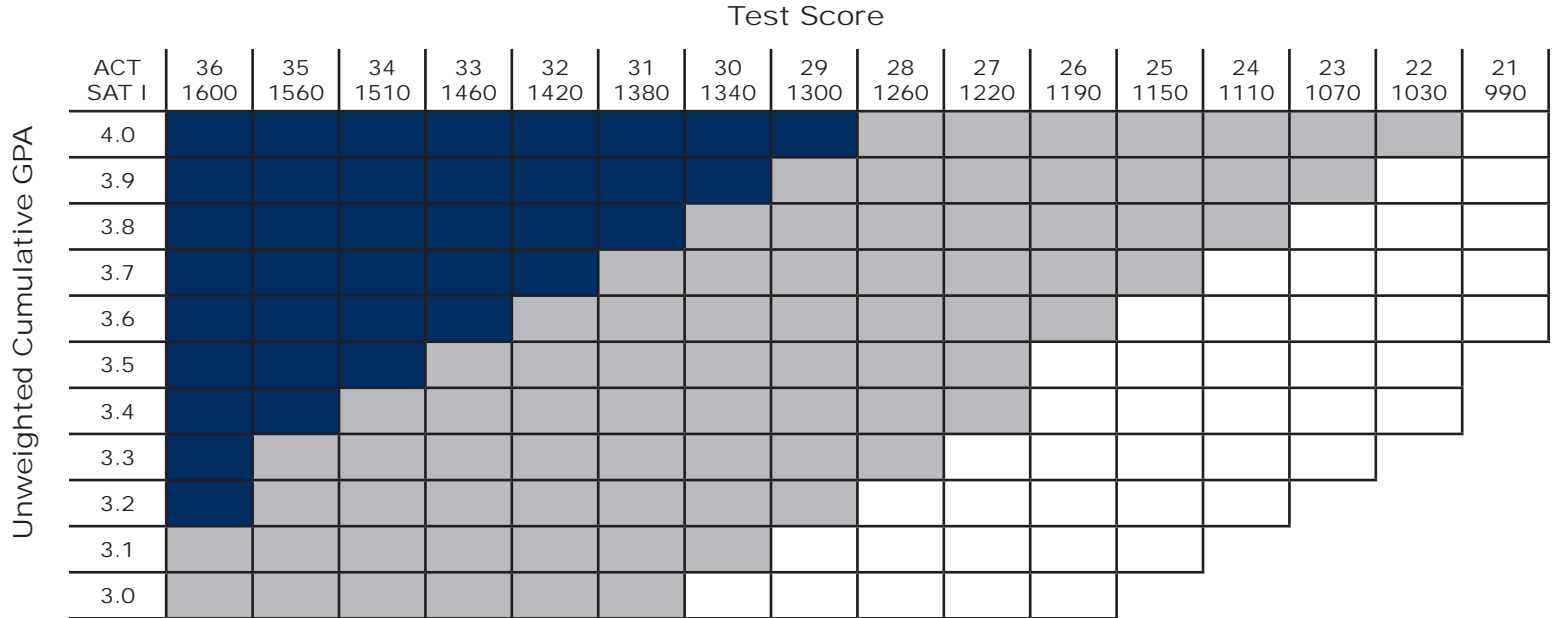

New Freshmen Scholarships

WHAT IS IT?

Students who present qualifying academic credentials in their admission application are awarded scholarships upon admission to the University. Scholarship offers are determined through the use of an academic index. The index is calculated using the high school unweighted cumulative GPA and the highest ACT or SAT I test score, to determine eligibility and offer amount. SAT I test score is the combination of the Verbal\Critical Reading and Math sections.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR NEW FRESHMEN SCHOLARSHIPS?

The Application for Admission is the same application for scholarships. The priority application deadline for scholarships is February 1st. After which scholarships are awarded on a “funds available” basis . New Freshmen Scholarships are awarded only in the fall.

OTHER UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA SCHOLARSHIPS

The most prestigious scholarship, the National Merit Scholarship, awards scholarships to entering freshmen students who are National Merit Finalists. This scholarship awards qualifying students \$15,000 per year for four years of undergraduate study, a \$60,000 scholarship. The Presidential Scholarship is available to entering freshmen who have a minimum 3.5 unweighted cumulative high school GPA and a minimum 31 ACT or 1360 SAT I test score. This scholarship is available at \$5,000 per year for four years of undergraduate study, a \$20,000 scholarship.

THE FINE PRINT

The Scholarship Matrix is for new freshmen to the University. Awards will be based on official high school transcripts and test scores received in the Office of Admissions and Records prior to February 1st. Scholarship amounts and award criteria are subject to change.
